Our core business is to test the quality, safety and authenticity of food and feed along the entire value chain.

Eurofins recognises the need to limit the increase in global warming to below 2 degrees (ideally 1.5 degrees) as set out in the Paris Climate Agreement and is aware of its corporate responsibility to protect the environment and in particular the climate.

Against this background, we are committed to regularly reviewing our business activities regarding relevant environmental impacts as part of our environmental management system and to minimising negative impacts through suitable targets and measures.

The focus is on the following topics:

- Assessing CO2 emissions (Scope 1-3) annually and implementing measures to reduce them
- · Monitoring energy consumption and optimising it as far as possible
- · Avoiding waste as far as possible and recycling and reusing as much of it as possible

We also undertake to comply with binding obligations arising from environmental legislation and regulatory requirements as well as other interested parties and to maintain an open dialog on environmentally relevant topics.

We are also working to continuously improve our environmental management system with the aim of improving our environmental performance.

Our management and executives are aware of these obligations and support compliance with them through appropriate resources and operational integration in their respective areas of responsibility. They support employees in contributing to the effectiveness of the environmental management system.
